2. Your attention is invited to the following features of this acquisition:


a. This is a competitive solicitation, under full and open competition (unrestricted) conditions. The Government intends to award one contract, but reserves the right to award none at all as a result of this RFP. The Government intends to award a contract resulting from this solicitation to the responsible offeror whose offer, conforming to the solicitation, will be the most advantageous to the Government, in accordance with the Evaluation Factors for Award. The basis for award is the Lowest Price Technically Acceptable (LPTA) Proposal.

b. The basic contract will contain firm fixed price, cost reimbursable and time and material contract line item numbers.

c. The basic contract period of performance is 12 months after contract award; options, if exercised, could extend the period of performance an additional 48 months.

d. Request you provide a complete Technical and Cost Proposal by 26 February 2001. The Technical Proposal should include a Statement of Work, describing how you would accomplish the tasks listed in the Statement of Objectives, and follow all directions provided in Section L of the RFP when submitting your proposal. The Cost Proposal should include cost and pricing information for Product Support Services, Spares and Repair/Maintenance Labor contract line items (based upon the Best Estimated Quantity of labor hours).

3. Request you complete all certifications and representations included in the RFP. Indicate N/A for items not applicable.
4. If your company qualifies as a small business, a Small and Small Disadvantaged Business Subcontracting Plan is required with your proposal. See page 24 for applicable clause, DFAR 252.219-7003.
5. For planning purposes, an April 2001 award is anticipated.
6. The due date for submission of your proposal is 26 Feb 2001 at 2:00 PM EST. Information concerning past performance is due on 06 February 2001. Your proposal in electronic format, either 3.5" diskette or CD-ROM is desirable, electronic media include Microsoft Word and/or Excel. However, paper copies will also be required.
